Parents' obligations in case of an extended absence:

Communication:

Parents should inform the homeroom teacher and the Head as soon as possible about the upcoming absence, providing details on the duration of the absence. Students and/or parents are responsible for regular communication with peers during the absence.

Access to Materials:

During a medical absence, if requested by the parents, kindergarten teachers suggest relevant activities, topics/themes...
