Therefore, the role of student presence in the International Baccalaureate (IB) assessment process is essential for ensuring a comprehensive and effective evaluation of academic performance.

Student's and/or parents' obligations in case of an extended absence:

Communication:

The student and/or their parents should inform the homeroom teacher and the Head as soon as possible about the upcoming absence, providing details on the duration and reason for the absence.

Students and/or parents are responsible for regular communication with peers during the absence.

Access to Materials:

During a medical absence, students and/or parents should contact their peers in order to have access to necessary educational materials and resources during the absence. If the access to the materials is unavailable, they should contact their teachers.

In case of any other absence, students and/or parents are responsible for regular communication with peers in order access materials.

During the absence, If possible, the school will provide access to online platforms or class materials to keep up with lessons.

Parents should stay involved in their child's education during the absence and support their child's learning process by giving them time to study.

Catching up:

Students and/or parents should proactively request and complete any makeup assignments or assessments they missed during their absence.

They must contact teachers and work closely with them to understand the expectations and deadlines for completing missed assignments and assessments.

Students must attend extra help lessons upon their return to ensure a smooth reintegration into the learning environment.

Consequences for Non-Compliance:

Recognise that failure to catch up on missing work may result in repeating the class.
