From 13 to 14 March, seven of the staff from DKIS travelled to Sofia, Bulgaria – 2026’s venue for the annually held CEESA (Central and Eastern European Schools Association) conference.

CEESA is a collaborative network of international schools aimed at enhancing school effectiveness, inspiring student learning and fostering educator development in the region. This year's theme was *The Heart and Art of Teaching* — celebrating the blend of skill, creativity, and humanity in education, with some of the keynote speakers highlighting the need for a more considerate, understanding and empathetic approach to teaching. Medical Check-ups

Dear DKIS community,

The 2M, 4M, 6M, 8I and 8M students will have a medical check-up according to the following schedule:

The teachers will meet the first group at ZD Bežigrad at 07:45 and escort them back to school after the check-up. The second group will be escorted to ZD Bežigrad at 09:45 from the school and will also be accompanied back to school after the check-up. We will inform you of the group allocation in due course.

The dates for each grade are as follows:

- 1 April – 4M
- 3 April – 8M
- 10 April – 6M
- 16 April – 8I
- 17 April – 2M

The students who do not have Slovenian health insurance must bring an identification document to the examination. If any students have a designated personal paediatrician in Slovenia, they should also bring a completed “Summary of Medical Record” form.

Please ensure that the vaccination card is translated.

If your child has **not** completed a medical check-up through our school, please ensure that you take the “*karton povzetek*” form to your child’s personal doctor. The doctor will need to complete **Part 1** of this form.

Parts 2 and 3 will be completed during the medical check-up conducted by ZD Bežigrad.

If your child has already completed a medical check-up during previous school years, there is **no need to bring the “karton povzetek” form**, as the records are already available in the ZD Bežigrad system.

MYP 3 Workshops in March 2026

In March, we will organise some workshops about **Mental Health**:

- **On Monday 30 March, during the 1st lesson in 8I.**

The objectives of the workshops are to:

- Learn about the importance of mental health and the ways to care for their own well-being.
- Take part in interactive activities and group discussions.
- Explore everyday challenges and sources of stress at school, at home, and in peer relationships.
- Become familiar with practical strategies for coping with stress and managing difficult emotions.
