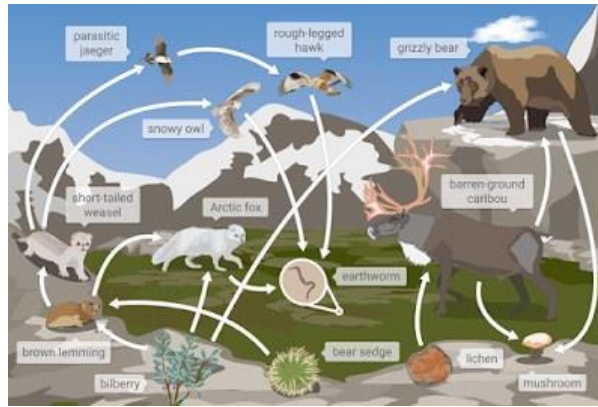

- Grades 1–3: Activities at Bit Center

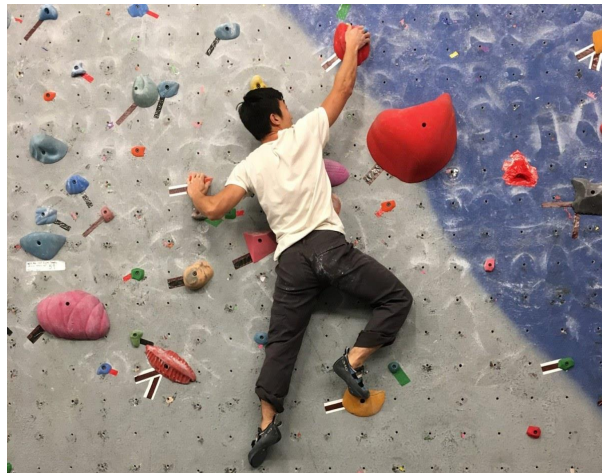
The students who receive school snack will take it with them. Lunch and AP will take place as usual.

CURRICULUM SECTION

MYP Interdisciplinary Units

As the students will soon receive their final report cards, you may notice a section dedicated to **Interdisciplinary Units (IDUs)**.

In the MYP, learning goes beyond individual subjects taught in isolation. Interdisciplinary units are designed to help students make meaningful connections between different areas of knowledge and understand how learning applies in real-world contexts. By bringing together two subject areas, these units encourage students to explore topics from multiple perspectives and develop deeper, more integrated understanding.

Each year, the students complete one interdisciplinary unit. At our school, these are structured as follows:

- **MYP 1 (Grade 6):** Theatre & English (Puppetry)
- **MYP 2 (Grade 7):** History & English (Around the World)
- **MYP 3 (Grade 8):** Mathematics & Design (Prototype Production)

The students are assessed on their ability to **evaluate**, **synthesize**, and **reflect** across the disciplines involved. Their performance is reported as a final grade on a scale of **1–7**, in the same way as any other subject, and this grade appears as a separate component on the report card.
